

COURSE AIMS:

Students will have the opportunity to know the evolution of religious dogmas for understanding Post-Byzantine art and particularly for understanding the Themes of icons on glass in Transylvania.

Students will be able to acquire and apply techniques of glass painting, in particular of the glass icon in Transylvania.

COURSE CONTENTS (for each workshop):

- 1. May 16th, two hours (11.00 am 01.00 pm): Church Art in the 19th Century (Modern Age)
 - A. Themes of icons on glass in Transylvania. 18th-19th Centuries. PowerPoint Presentation.
 - 1. Introduction about the main centres of glass icon painting in Transylvania,
 - 2. Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Trinity (e.g. Jesus Christ Pantocrator, Eucharistic Christ)
 - 3. The Holy Virgin (e.g. The Holty Virgin Hodighitria, Our Lady of Sorrows),
 - 4. Imperial funeral feasts, celebrations of the Holy Virgin and other themes depicted in the Transylvanian icons on glass,
 - 5. Themes of Lent and of the Holy Week,
 - 6. Depictions of saints in the icons on glass in Transylvania,
 - 7. Other themes depicted in the icons on glass in Transylvania.
 - B. Techniques in glass painting in Transylvania. Power Point presentation. First Part.
- 2. May 17th, three hours. Church Art in the Contemporary Period. Workshop:

- A. Techniques in the glass painting of Transylvania. Power Point presentation. Second Part.
- B. Making a glass icon or an artistic painting inspired by the glass icon technique
